3 rd Sunday of the Month:	A jar of Peanut Butter
4 th Sunday of the Month:	A can of fruit or vegetables
5 th Sunday of the Month:	A box of powdered milk

Beans

 Canned Fruit and Vegetables
(Pop-top lids on the cans are preferred)
